Molten to Supply the Official Match Ball Designed Exclusively for the UEFA Europa League



Molten Corporation (headquarters: Hiroshima, Japan; president & CEO: Kiyoo Tamiaki), a manufacturer of competition quality sports balls and equipment, and the Union of European Football Associations (UEFA) (headquarters: Nyon, Switzerland; president: Aleksander Čeferin) have announced a new partnership agreement for Molten to become an Official Licensing Partner of the UEFA Europa League.
